Additional officers along with the Cambridge Police Department were notified and arrived to assist in the search for the suspects. During the search, officers located the bicycle that the suspects were observed riding as well as a pair of bolt cutters. Officers then observed one of the suspects in question lying in the bushes. Officers confirmed that this was in fact the suspect that fled the scene earlier. A show up identification was conducted and the reporting party confirmed that suspect in question was one of the suspects that was observed attempting to steal the bicycle.
